

Advantageous offer.

The College makes the following reduction in favor of parents who have more than one boy to educate: For two boys a deduction of \$15.00. For three boys a deduction of \$50.00. The fourth boy is admitted gratuitously.

This deduction is granted on the board of students but never on the Tuition, etc.

Required.

Students should be provided with the following articles: shoe-brush and blacking, clothes-brush, tooth-brush, hair-brush, comb, fine comb, soap, towels and napkins.

They should also have sufficient wearing apparel.

The College costume or uniform consists of a black coat almost reaching the knees (Prince Albert Style), black pantaloons, a black casquette (cap) and a blue sash. Pupils are obliged to wear this uniform on Sundays and when they appear to the public in a corps.

The Uniform, casquette, sash and stationery can be procured at the College at current prices.

Any damage caused by a student to the furniture, etc., is charged to his account.

Students should have their clothing well marked.

The Institution will not furnish clothes, etc., unless a sufficient sum be deposited with the Bursar for that purpose.

Payments.

Payments should be regularly made quarterly in advance (unless otherwise agreed), viz: At the beginning of September, on the 15th of November, on the 1st of February and on the 15th of April. Accounts shall be sent quarterly.

The months of september and june are always payable in full.

Interest shall be charged on accounts not paid on july 1st. No deduction is made for absence or withdrawal from the College for a shorter time than a
