MARINE NOTES OF THE WORLD

ANOTHER FREIGHT STEAMER.
Another freight steamer, built for carrying coal or general cargo, will be launched at Newport News on Oct 4. She is named the Lewis K. Thurlov and is built on the same general lines as the Peter H. Crowell, although she will have greater carrying capacity. She is built of steel and measures 313.6 feet in length, 46.1 feet beam and 25 feet depth of hold, with a carrying capacity of 5200 tons. She is owned in Boston and is expected to have her in commission by the middle of November.

STEAMER NOTES.
The steamer Manchester Exchange with a general cargo left port Saturday for Manchester.
The White Star Dominion Line Str Laurentic was one hundred and seventy miles northeast of Cape Race at noon of Sept. 18. Due at Quebec early Sunday morning, at Montreal Saturday to land apples.

THE DERELICT SCHOONER.
Halifax Echo: Howard Compton, one of the owners of the American derelict schooner Lottie E. Russell, now lying bottom up near the Dartmouth shore of the harbor, has arrived in the city from Philadelphia and inspected his ship. Tenders are out for the taking out of the cargo of the Lottie E. and righting her. The schooner's cargo consists of 170,000 feet of pine, worth about \$2,000. This was fully covered by insurance, which has been paid, and the cargo will be turned over to the underwriters, less the general average charges.

ARRIVED AT PERNAMBUCO.
A cable from Pernambuco announces the arrival there of the schooner Emily Anderson last Saturday. The Emily Anderson sailed from Halifax on July 30th. Her cargo of dry fish was shipped by Robin, Jones and Whitman. The vessel, after discharging will proceed in ballast to Barbados.

New York, Sept. 20.—Transactions were on a small scale today, being curtailed by a holiday in London, and the coming half day on Monday. The market was thin. It declined at the opening on small transactions. The weakness of Rock Island share being a feature. Wall street seems to think that Rock Island cannot avoid a receivership this year with short crops and reductions in production rates. However, its securities are selling at low prices, and it should be kept in mind that the property itself has great merit. During the last hour generally firm tone prevailed, and fractional advances were scored. There was good buying in Canadian Pacific. As a whole, the day's trading was colorless.

New York, Sept. 20.—The market has been active and strong this morning, and is rebuying by sold out bulls, covering by recent sellers for a reaction, and increased trade demand. Prices made new high grounds for the season although there was heavy realizing by old longs. This advance reflected various features, pointing to a small crop and increased nervousness on the part of spinners. Liverpool cables attributed the advance there to report that Texas exporters were laying down on their forward shipments. Coupled with this was an unfavorable weather situation.
