Reed has agreed to make a full confession covering his deals in which the bank's money was used.

33,300 FIRE AT CALAIS SATURDAY. St. Stephen, Jan. 24—(Special)—On Saturday evening a fire broke out at Calais in the wholesale flour and feed store of H. Phelan. The building and stock was practically a total loss. The value of the stock was \$33,300; insurance, \$17,700. The building was owned by Frank Wright who had no insurance. The building next to Phelan's and occupied by Douglas Bros., marble works, was also damaged.

\$250,000 New York Fire. New York, Jan. 24—The building Nos. 348-349 Broadway, occupied by Morris Bros., Japanese goods, L. E. Bonn, Co., and Cranford & Qu'ey, Rosenwasser Bros. and Finkstein and Maugat, clothing, was destroyed by fire early today. The total loss is estimated at \$250,000.
