ings of the Corporation shall be called and held, and may, at any subsequent General Meeting to be so called and held, amend or repeal the said By-laws or any of them.

IV. And be it enacted, That the property now held by, in trust for, or to the use of *The Upper Canada Religious Tract and Book Society*, shall be and is hereby vested in the Corporation hereby constituted, for the uses and purposes thereof. Certain property vested in the Corporation.

V. And be it enacted, That all the property which shall at any time belong to the said Corporation, as well as the revenue arising therefrom, shall at all times be exclusively applied and appropriated to the purposes mentioned in the Preamble to this Act, and to no other object. To what purposes only property shall be applied.

VI. And be it enacted, That no Member of the said Corporation shall in his private or individual capacity be liable for any debts or obligations of the Corporation. Non-liability of Members.

VII. And be it enacted, That it shall be incumbent on the said Corporation to submit annually to each of the three branches of the Legislature, during the first fifteen days of each Session thereof, a detailed statement, shewing all the real or immoveable property held by them, with the estimated value thereof, and the revenue derived therefrom. Annual Return to Parliament.

VIII. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Act. Public Act.
