LIV. And be it enacted, That any contravention of this Any contra-Act by the said Company, or by any other party, for which vention of this no punishment or penalty is herein provided, shall be a wise punishmisdemeanor, and shall be punishable accordingly; but able to be a misdemeanor. such punishment shall not exempt the said Company (if they be the offending party) from the forfeiture of this Act, and the privileges hereby conferred on them, if by the provisions thereof or by law the same he forfeited by such contravention.

LV. And be it enacted, That Her Majesty, Her Heirs Her Majesty and Successors, may at any time before or after the said may assume the Railroad, Railroad is completed, assume the possession and property on cortain conthereof, and of all the property which the said Company is hereby empowered to hold and shall then have, and of

15 all the rights, privileges and advantages vested by this Act in the said Company, (all which shall, after such assumption, be vested in Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors,) on giving to the said Company three months' notice of the intention to assume the same, and on paying 20 to the said Company, within three months of the expiration of such notice, the whole amount of their Capital Stock, then paid up and expended, with interest on the

paid up Capital, from the time of the paying up of the same until the time of the opening of the said Railroad.

LVI. And be it enacted, That the said Company, to Map and Book 25 entitle themselves to the benefits and advantages to them of reference to be deposited granted by this Act, shall and they are hereby required and the Railto make and deposit the map or plan and book of refer-road to be ence mentioned in the fourth Section of this Act within within certain six months after the section of the

30 six months after the passing thereof, and to make and Act to be void. complete the said Railroad from Industry Village to the Village or Township of Rawdon, in manner aforesaid, within three years from the passing of this Act; and if the said map or plan and book of reference be not so made 35 and deposited within the said six months, or if the said

Railroad shall not be so made and completed within the said period so as to be used by the public as aforesaid, then and in either case this Act and every matter and thing therein contained, shall cease and be utterly null 40 and void.

LVIL And be it enacted, That the said Company Company anshall annually submit to the three Branches of the Legis-mit to the Legis-mit to the Legislature, within the first fifteen days after the opening of gislature deeach Session of the Provincial Parliament, after the
