

An Act to Incorporate the Village of South Quebec, in the County of Lévis.

WHEREAS vast improvements have been made, and require to be made, to meet the exigencies of commerce in a certain portion of the Parish of Notre Dame de la Victoire, in the County of Lévis: And whereas it is impossible to make these improvements or to carry into effect those already made, under the control of the Municipal Council as now constituted by law: And whereas the Village at the Terminus of the Grand Trunk Railway, situate in that portion of the said Parish, has of late so augmented, and by reason of the construction of docks, warehouses and wharves, promises to be so further augmented, and the Roads and Bridges, in such part of the said Parish, are at once so important and so disconnected from those of the other part of the said Parish, as to make it expedient that the south-western part of the said Parish, hereinafter described, wherein the said terminus, docks, warehouses and wharves are situate, should be separated from the remainder of the said Parish, and constituted a Village Municipality: And whereas a great number of the inhabitants interested have, by petition prayed for the passing of an Act for that purpose, and for vesting in the Corporation of the said Village the necessary powers for establishing, regulating and licensing a Ferry from the said Village to Quebec, as hereinafter mentioned, and for macadamizing the beach road now under the control of the Turnpike Trust for the south side of the River St. Lawrence, with the same powers and interests as are vested in the said Trust: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with, &c.

I. From and after the day on which the election hereinafter provided for shall have taken place, all that part of the Parish of Notre Dame de la Victoire, in the County of Lévis, comprised within the boundaries mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, shall be detached from the Municipality of the Parish of Notre Dame de la Victoire, and shall become an Incorporated Village, and the inhabitants thereof shall be, and they are hereby constituted a Corporation or Body Politic, under the name of "The Corporation of the Village of South Quebec," for all municipal purposes, to all intents as if the erection of such Village had on such day taken place in ordinary course under the provisions of the "Lower Canada Consolidated Municipal Act;" and the Municipal Council of the said Village shall, in addition to all the powers conferred by the said Act on the Councils of Incorporated Villages, have full power and authority (notwithstanding any thing in any Act relating to the City of Quebec, or respecting Ferries over the River St. Lawrence) for establishing, regulating and licensing a Ferry between the said Village and Quebec, for the period of one year, or such longer period as the said Council may from time to time find expedient; and of macadamizing and improving the beach road, within the said Village, now under the control of the Quebec South Shore Turnpike Road Trustees, which shall be, by virtue of this Act, transferred to and vested in the Corporation of the said Village, with the same powers and duties
