Tunics; Trowsers, Shakos, Busbies and Great Coats are the only articles supplied by the Department, to be charged either against the Drill pay or the allowance in lieu of clothing, under the provisions of the General Order of the 29th March, 1866.

Officers ordering uniforms for the Non Commissioned Officers and Men of their Corps will state whether the clothing required is to be of the old or of the new pattern. All applications for additional articles are to be made through the officer commanding.

The old pattern uniform is:—For Infantry, scarlet Tunic, and Oxford Trowsers; for Rifles, green Tunic and green Trowsers; Artillery same as Royal Artillery—Hussar, blue Tunic, blue Trowsers and Busby—buff facing. The new pattern uniform will be serge Norfolk Jacket, serge Trowsers, and shako :
