Burt, lost his life in the fatal crash of an aircraft at Calgary. W/C Burt had just recently been appointed Principal Medical Officer of the amalgamated two commands.	
	28 Nov/44	Tuesday	C.21079 F/O C.G. McPherson (Accts) left the station today on posting to No. 3 S.F.T.S. This officer's conscientious devotion to duty was responsible in large measure for the very satisfactory condition of all N.P. Funds and equipment. Macpherson (C557) (Admin) who has commanded this station since April, 1943, and who has remained with the Rear Party, is leaving on balance of Annual leave, pending return to civil life. C9702 F/L O.O. Blevins (Equip) will assume command of the rear party. Despite depressing aspects of closing of station, the morale of all ranks has been maintained at a high level. Inventories and N.P. Funds are in splendid shape and disbandment is proceeding satisfactorily; all of which reflects favourably on all ranks of the station. The Equipment Section is taking a 100% stock check of Medical Equipment.
