
Ottawa, March 15, 1911.

Rev. Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, and in reply I beg to say that the Department cannot consider the question of translating the text book on hygiene into the Cree language for the use of the Indians.

I may also say that the Department is not aware of any lantern slides which can be used to illustrate talks on hygiene. It might be possible for you to obtain this information through correspondence with some of the firms who deal in supplies of this kind.
