in reply to your letter of the 25th instant I beg to say that the Department will sanction the admission of three or four children from the Saugeen Indian Reserve and the same number from Cape Croker to the Industrial school at Spanish River and Rev. Father Dugas, Principal of the school, will be so informed.

admission, which should be properly filled in, and the applicants should be examined by a doctor, who should fill in the certificase of health on the back of the application form. These forms should be taken to the school by the person who accompanies the children and should be handed to the Principal.

The Department will agree to pay the transport of the children and the person who accompanies them at the rate mentioned by you, viz. \$5.00 each.
