The Director.Re Musqueam Indian Reserve.

In reply to your telephone enquiry, the situation with respect to the installation of the water service on the Musqueam Indian Reserve and with respect to the taxation of Chinese tenants would appear to be quite clearly indicated in the correspondence hereunder.

Under date of June 6th, 1942, you wrote Major MacKay (letter outturned) directing him to discuss the whole problem with the administrative officers of the City of Vancouver.

In Major MacKay's reply, dated July 10th, he reports that he has an appointment with the city officials early in August, that in the meantime no work has been undertaken on the water project, and that nothing further will be done pending the result of negotiations and specific instructions from this office.
