

EVIDENCE TO COVER UP DEFICIENCIES IN SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

B. 63627 A/CPL SMITH, W.G. having been duly sworn state:

I was directly involved of "C" Coy on the 18th and 19th July 1942. The accused was A.W.K. that night from 2300. As a result of information that received I personally checked the billet and found him absent at that time. I went off duty at 2315 hrs at which time there were parcels of cigarettes and other mail in the Guard Room. At 0600 hrs the next morning when I returned, all the cigarettes and one parcel were missing. The only two new arriving from the Coy lists were Rfn Beaumont & Rfn Reid.

The individuals who are named in charge three of the present charge sheet are the men whose cigarettes were missing from the Coy Guard Room on July 19th 1942.
