MEMORANDUM FOR FILE:

1. It was reported by Mr. D. Pickering of Laurentian Air Services that he had been informed by one of the local inhabitants that one of Mr. R. Bradley's aircraft had crashed in a tree near MacKay Lake fifteen miles north of Fort Coulonge.
2. Mr. Bradley was telephoned by the undersigned and he confirmed the above report and stated that the aircraft was a Piper J3, CF-DGO, equipped with floats which had in fact crashed into the trees on September 26th, but fortunately no one was injured. He stated that a report had been forwarded to Toronto with a copy addressed to this Headquarters.
