not show an atrophy of glomeruli or tubules due to other reasons; scar formation remains, therefore, quite limited and follows strictly in the path of the lost substance.

In a previous communication, <sup>33</sup> it has been shown that a cyanotic induration, *Stauungschrumpfniere*, does not exist, and that cases thus described are either of Groups b, productive nephritis, or of the arteriosclerotic non-inflammatory atrophy of the kidney associated with stasis.
