WANT PRICES FIXED

The members of the Sherwood local of the S.G.G.A. in a recent meeting at Burnhamthorpe, Sask., unanimously passed the following resolution:—
"In adopting the Farmers' National Political Platform, we would recommend the addition of the following plank:—
"1.—That the government fix a standard price for all classes of machinery and manufactured goods and a schedule of wages for labor.
"2.—That the government amend the Municipal act so as to permit each municipality to carry its own debt; that such debentures to be issued in small denominations and spread over a period of from five to ten years.
"3.—That a municipal council shall have full power to construct roads in a municipality, when so authorized by a majority vote of the resident owners of land in the said municipality; such council may employ for this work any farmers who are willing to co-operate in the construction of roads, but all roads so constructed must conform to a government standard."
