

Coasts, but as calling forth an habitual exercise of that public spirit, which is essential to the prosperity of the Country.

I still recommend to your serious attention, and I will yet depend upon that support which has been long and steadily given to the Executive Government, and which has, eminently contributed to the peace, prosperity and security, of the Province.

I thank you for the liberal grants you have voted for the Public Service, they shall be applied with the utmost care, to the objects to which they have been appropriated.

As the time, limited by law, for the duration of this General Assembly, will soon expire, it will become my duty, in the course of the summer, to dissolve it, and call a new Assembly. It must be highly gratifying to you, to reflect, that this Assembly has now advanced to its latest period, in cordial and uninterrupted unanimity between the several branches of the Legislature. Your zeal, your persevering endeavours, and your liberality, in promoting objects of public interest, have been uniform in each succeeding Session.

The advantages arising from that honorable and faithful discharge of your public duties, must be widely felt, and gratefully acknowledged; to me it is most pleasing, thus to record my testimony at the close of this Assembly; and I now take my leave of you, with a fervent prayer, that happiness and prosperity may attend you all individually.
