Votes; One Booth on the Bay Bulls Road, at which all Electors residing between Wateford Bridge and the Northern Goulds' Bridge, shall deliver their Votes; One additional Booth at Petty Harbor, at which Electors residing on the South Side thereof shall deliver their Votes; and One Booth at the South Side of St. John's Harbor, at which Electors residing on the said South Side of St. John's Harbor shall deliver their Votes.

Given under the Great Seal of Our aforesaid Island of Newfoundland.
