Summary of its Provisions as Finally Passed. The following are the main heads of the Land bill as it has finally passed both houses of Parliament...

1. Tenant may sell his tenancy for the best price he can get. 2. Sale to one person only. 3. Notice to landlord. 4. Landlord may purchase on receiving notice...

5. Tenant must state consideration. 6. Court may declare sale void. 7. Landlord may purchase on receiving notice. 8. Tenant may purchase on receiving notice...

9. Tenant may purchase on receiving notice. 10. Where purchase money paid into Court, Court must determine all applications. 11. Tenant who has sold his tenancy shall not be entitled to compensation for disturbance or improvement...
