## Latest Despatches.

IMPORTANT FROM SPAIN

London-midnight-Feb. 12. The abdication of Amadeus is the all-absorbing topic in London and Paris. The view is considered gloomy, and a bitter civil war is inevitable.

The last despatch from Madrid was dated 1 o'clock this morning, There The last despatch says the streets are filled with crowds of excited people. The Senate has appointed a permanent of the Bourbon cause. Committee of Thirty. Senator Malcampo and Admiral Topete, in behalf of Marshal Serrano, have offered their support to Prime Minister Zorilla in maintaining order. It is rumored that Zorilla intends leaving the capital tomorrow.

LONDON, 13th, a.m. The abdication of Amadeus produces a profound sensation in Berlin. The German papers hint that it was carried by French intrigue.

There has been an insurrection of the natives against the Portuguese authorities in Leonda, on the southwest coast of Africa. Portuguese troops have been sent to the colony.

The following from Madrid has just been received :- It is believed that Rivero, President of the Cortes, will be elected President of the Provisional Republic, established by the vote last night. Perfect order has been preserved in Madrid. The attitude of the regular troops and of the national guards is satisfactory.

of Amadeus was read in each Chamber. It opens with the statement that the King has maturely considered the question of what course he ought to pursue with reference to the Spanish throne. When he accepted the crown, he did so under the belief that the loyalty of the people who had called him would compensate for the inexperience which he brought to his task. He had found that herein he was deceived. If those who had his faith had been foreigners he would not have taken the course now determined upon; but they are Spaniards. By them Spain has been kept in perpetual disquiet. All his efforts to quiet or put an end to the intrigues which were the source of her agitation has proved unavailing. It is not enough that he had a partisan support. He had no wish to remain on the throne as the king of a party. He therefore announced his abdication on behalf of himself and his heirs. A vote was taken on the question, accepting without discussion. The abdication of Amedeus was accepted unanimously.
