In connection with the amend ment to the special war revenue act, effective on October 1st by which form letters and postcards acknowledging the payment of \$10.00 bee; Child Welfare Committee, Miss and upward become subject to the stamp tax on receipts, the following rulings have been issued by t he department of customs and excise.
