

A teaspoonful added to a glass of hot or cold water, and sweelened to the taste, will be found refreshing and invigorating.

WATER Ices are made of the juice of the fresh fruits pressed through a linen bag; to each pint of fruit is added half a pound of sugar, a gill of water, and a desert-spoonful of lemon-juice. When well-mixed freeze it like ice-cream and serve in a glass bowl.

STRAWBERRY DUMPLINGS. - Put one pint of sifted flour into a bowl, rub into it two ounces of butter, add a teaspoonful of baking powder and sufficient milk to moisten, about one gill; mix quickly, take out on a board and roll out into a sheet a quarter of an inch in thickness, cut into cakes with a round biscuit cutter, put about three strawber-ries in each cake, fold them over nicely and steam twenty minutes.

PINEAPPLE PYRAMID. - Make some good calvesfoot jelly, or get it from your grocer. Surround a pyramid-shaped mould with ice, keeping the pointed end upward; put in enough jelly to cover the bottom of the mould; when firm add a layer of diamond shaped pieces of piecespole uptil the mould is full and of pineapple until the mould is full and all the fruit is used. Keep it as cold as possible until wanted, then dip the mould quickly into hot water and turn out the form on an ice cold dish.

Coffee Mousse.—This is a com paratively new dessert, and has been popular of late at elegant dinners. Make a strong infusion by pouring one pint of boiling water over three heaping tablespoonsful of ground coffee in a strainer. Pour back and forth several times to get the full strength, and strain times to get the full strength, and strain through a cloth. Add the yelks of four beaten eggs, and one cup of sugar, and set over the fire to thicken. When cold add one fint of cream which has been whipped to a stiff froth, and put in the can of an ice cream freezer and pack solidly with ice and salt. RASPBERRY VINEGAR.—This is a luxury that may be indulged in by families living in the country who have an abundance of fruit. 
