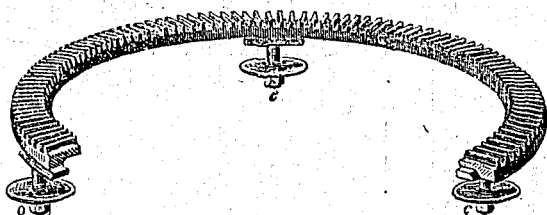


Fig. 2. Circular Chuck.
