VOTERS' LISTS BOOKS

AS REQUIRED BY THE ONTARIO VOTERS' LISTS ACT, 1898.

The Ontarie Voter's Lists Act was amended at last session by adding thereto wing section :-

(1) The clerk of the municipality shall keep a book in which he shall enter particulars the day on which the copies of the alphabetical list were posted up by him and were ed to each of the persons mentioned in sections 8 and 9, and also whether such copies ivered personally or transmitted by post. There shall be added to each such statement dars an affidavit or statutory declaration verifying the same. Any clerk who fails or omits to comply with the provisions of this section and of sections hall for each omission incur a penalty of \$200 and shall also be liable to be imprisoned od of three months in default of payment.
