ARTICLE I

Definitions

For the purposes of this Agreement:

- (a) "the Convention" means the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 13 February 1946;
- (b) "the University" means the United Nations University, established by resolution 2951 (XXVII) of the General Assembly of the United Nations of 11 December 1972;
- (c) "the Charter of the University" means the Charter of the University adopted by the United Nations General Assembly resolution 3081 (XXVIII) of 6 December 1973;
- (d) "Government" means the Government of Canada;
- (e) "INWEH" means the International Network on Water, Environment and Health, a research and training programme of the University;
- (f) "the Secretary-General" means the Secretary-General of the United Nations;
- (g) "the Rector" means the Rector of the University and, during his absence, any official designated to act on his behalf;
- (h) "the Director" means the Director of INWEH acting on behalf of the Rector in Canada, or in his absence any official designated to act on his behalf to be notified to the Government by the Director;
- "appropriate authorities" means the national, provincial, regional or local authorities of Canada as the context may require, in accordance with the laws of Canada;
- "official activities" means INWEH's activities and includes administrative activities:
- (k) "personnel of INWEH" means persons appointed in accordance with Article VIII, paragraph 7, of the Charter of the University;
- (l) "officials" means persons who are appointed under the United Nations Staff Regulations and Rules;
- (m) "experts" means persons, within the meaning of Article VI of the Convention;
- (n) "premises of INWEH" means the buildings or part of buildings occupied permanently or temporarily by the University or by meetings convened in Canada by the University for the purposes of INWEH;
- (o) "archives" means all records, correspondence, documents, manuscripts, photographs, films and recordings belonging to or held by the University, wherever located.
