Mr. Rogers, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copy of Order in Council passed under the provisions of the Relief Act, 1935, as follows:—

Order in Council, P.C. 354, dated February 12, 1936: providing for a change in the description of a bridge, to the cost of which the Dominion had agreed to contribute under an agreeement entered into between the Dominion and the province of Manitoba on September 20, 1935, across the Assiniboine River between the city of Winnipeg and St. James and at or near the village of Headingly.

On motion of Mr. Dunning, the Message of His Excellency the Governor General, together with the Estimates presented on the 11th instant, were referred to the Committee of Supply.

The Order being read for the House to resolve itself into Committee of Supply;

Mr. Dunning, by leave of the House, moved,—That Mr. Speaker do now

leave the Chair.

And the question being put on the said motion; it was agreed to.

The House accordingly resolved itself into Committee of Supply.
