For each year since 1984, what has been the average annual income of jobs created for (a) men (b) women (c) each occupational category for which figures are kept?

Hon. Barbara McDougall (Minister of Employment and Immigration): The attached Table 1 contains estimates of average earnings in Canada by occupation and sex for 1984, 1985, 1986 and 1987. The figures are averages of earnings of persons employed in an occupational category in a particular year; data are not available on average annual incomes of new jobs created in a particular year.

Also attached is Table 2 presenting data on jobs created between 1984 and 1988 by occupation and sex.
