- 4. When the Sergeant-at-Arms an-Mr. Speaker nounces that the Gentleman Usher of chair and the Black Rod is at the door, Mr. Black Rod. Speaker shall take the Chair, whether there be a quorum present or not.
- 5. Every member is bound to attend Attendance required. the service of the House, unless leave of absence has been given him by the House.
- 6. (1) At 6.00 o'clock p.m., except on Evening sittings. Wednesdays and Fridays, Mr. Speaker shall leave the Chair until 8.00 o'clock p.m.
- (2) At 1.00 o'clock p.m. on any day Mid-day upon which a morning sitting of the House is held, Mr. Speaker shall leave the Chair until 2.30 o'clock p.m.
  - (3) At 6.00 o'clock p.m. on Wednes-Evening days and Fridays and at 10.00 o'clock p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays, unless hereunder otherwise provided, Mr. Speaker shall adjourn the House without question put until the next sitting day.
