**Orders of the Day:**

Certain ones withdrawn, 487. Certain one revived and again placed on Order Paper, 656. (See also Quorum.) Third reading of Bill rescinded and again placed on Order Paper for consideration in Committee of the Whole, 699. Motion to proceed to Orders of the Day, agreed to (Yeas 35; Nays 20), 1078. Motion that House proceed to another Order, ruled out of order, 1080. Motion (Sir Robert Borden) that Orders be now read; agreed to, 1085, 1089; withdrawn, 1099.
