- 1. The Joint Committee on the Library of Library. Parliament, whereto there shall be appointed seventeen senators.
- 2. The Joint Committee on the Printing of Printing. Parliament, whereto there shall be appointed twenty-one senators.
- 3. The Committee on Standing Orders, Standing Composed of fifteen senators.
- 4. The Committee on Banking and Com-Banking. merce, composed of fifty senators.
- 5. The Committee on Transport and Communications, composed of not more than seventeen senators.
- 6. The Committee on Miscellaneous Priv- Private Bills. ate Bills, composed of thirty-five senators.
- 7. The Committee on Internal Economy Internal and Contingent Accounts, composed of twenty-five senators.
