78. The Standing Committees shall be as follows:

1. The Joint Committee on the Library of Parliament, whereto there shall be appointed seventeen senators. Library.

2. The Joint Committee on the Printing of Parliament, whereto there shall be appointed twenty-one senators. Printing.

3. The Committee on Standing Orders, composed of fifteen senators. Standing Orders.

4. The Committee on Banking and Commerce, composed of fifty senators. Banking.

5. The Committee on Transport and Communications, composed of not more than seventeen senators. Transport.

6. The Committee on Miscellaneous Private Bills, composed of thirty-five senators. Private Bills.

7. The Committee on Internal Economy and Contingent Accounts, composed of twenty-five senators. Internal Economy.

8. The Committee on Debates and Reporting, composed of nine senators. Debates.
