Article 2.—Ordinary Meetings of the Commission-Meetings of the cry shall be held on Wednesday in each week, and Monthly Meetings shall be held on the first Thursday of each month, at such hour respectively as may be fixed for such meetings by resolution, at which meetings any business within the jurisdiction of the Commissioners may be dealt with and disposed of; and such Monthly Meetings shall be open to the public.

Article 3.—Special Meetings of the Commissioners Special Meetings be called by the President or by any three of the Commissioners; and a notice of every such Special Meeting shall be sent by the Secretary to each Commissioner, specifying the object for which such Special Meeting is called. And no other business shall be transacted at any Special Meeting other than that which is specified in the notice so sent, or such business as is incidental or accessory thereto.

Article 4.—At any Ordinary or Monthly Meeting, Standing Committees may be or at any Special Meeting called for the purpose, the appointed. Commissioners may appoint Standing Committees, composed of Commissioners, in such numbers and for such purposes as may be determined by the resolution appointing such Standing Committees. And such Standing Committees shall have the right to deal with all matters within the limits of the purpose for which they are so appointed respectively, to the extent to which they shall be authorized so to do by such resolution; provided always that they shall not finally determine or do any matter or thing which by law falls solely within the jurisdiction of the Commissioners. And such Standing Committees shall report their deliberations
