

CONSTITUTION

Adopted at meeting held 13th December, 1909.

Amended 24th April, 1911, and 12th June, 1911, and 30th December, 1912.

NAME

1. The name of the Society shall be "The Natural History Society of British Columbia."

OBJECTS

2. The objects of this Society shall be:

- (a) To promote the study of the natural sciences and historical research, especially so far as they relate to the Province of British Columbia.
- (b) To collect all available data in connection therewith, to act as an independent auxiliary to the Provincial Museum, Department of Agriculture, Department of Mines, and Library of the Legislative Assembly.

MEMBERSHIP

3. There shall be five classes of members: Honorary, Corresponding, Ordinary, Associate and Temporary.
