An Ordinance respecting Short Forms of Indentures.

[Passed 10th June, 1881.]

Be it enar'd by the Lieutenant-Governor of the North-West Territories, in Council, as follows:

1. Whenever the words following occur in this Meaning of Ordinance, or in the Schedules thereto, they shall words. be construed in the manner hereinafter mentioned, unless there is something in the subject or context repugnant to such construction:

(1) "Lands" shall extend to all freehold tenements and hereditaments, whether corporeal or incorporeal, or any undivided part or share therein, respectively; and

(2) "Party" shall mean and include any body politic or corporate or collegiate, as well as an individual.

2. When a deed of conveyance, or a deed of mort-where words gage, or a deed of lease, respectively, made according to one of schethe forms set forth in the first, second and third Sche-ployed, deed dules to this Ordinance respectively, expressed to be to have the same effect as made "in pursuance of the Ordinance respecting Short to this Ordinant wo Forms of Indentures," or otherwise referring to this Or-were insertdinance, contains any of the forms or words in column ed. one under the said schedules respectively, and distinguished by any number therein, such deed shall be taken to have the same effect, and be construed as if it contained the form of words in column two under the same schedule and distinguished by the same number as is annexed to the form of words used in the deed,
