The fighting at 7 a.m. enabled a Japanese battery stationed on a height to rake the attacking force effectively. The Russians later began to retreat when the Japanese threatened their route of retreat, which was still further endangered by the advance of another detachment of Japanese on their left.

The Russian officers had collected their companies for retreat in close formation, as usual, making them splendid targets for the dark coats of the Japanese.
