AMITE, La., March 11.—The strained political situation in Louisiana Democratic circles was last night responsible for the killing of Democratic State Senator-elect D. S. Kemp of this city. He was shot and killed by C. F. Hyde, a young political and business leader of this section, who has not been arrested. The men quarreled about the recent Democratic primary for lieutenant-governor, and Hyde is alleged to have called Kemp a liar. Last night Kemp, with a drawn revolver, walked into Hyde's place of business, accompanied by a friend, and demanded an apology, which was refused. Kemp then slapped Hyde's face and the two men thereupon agreed to fight it out. Hyde secured a revolver. When he came out he shouted to Kemp to wait for him. The two approached each other and Hyde opened fire. Kemp did not shoot. King Visits Post.
