Britain and France May Adopt Eight Hour Day

Paris, April 4-A bill limiting the working day to eight hours will be introduced in the chamber of deputies on Tuesday next by order of Premier Clemenceau. AN OPTIMISTIC VIEW.

London, April 4-An optimistic view of the work of the industrial conference, comprising representatives of the employers and the trade unions of the United Kingdom was expressed at a joint meeting of the body held today to discuss a secret report made by the committee of ten that had been appointed to make recommendations as to an adjustment of the outstanding difficulties.




Separate meetings of the trade unionists and the employers were held this afternoon to consider the report.






