

Permission, having been asked, was granted to the Presbytery of Quebec to meet in St. Andrew's Church, Montreal, on the 9th inst., at ten o'clock in the forenoon, and thereafter by adjournment, for the purpose of hearing the probationary trials of Mr. Morrison, and if satisfied therewith, proceeding to license him.

The Synod adjourned to meet in this place on Monday forenoon at ten o'clock, of which public intimation was made, and this Diet was closed with praise and prayer.

At Montreal, and within St. Andrew's Church there ; Sabbath, the eighth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three years :—

Which day the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper was dispensed to the members of the Synod. Communicants belonging to the several Churches in this City were invited to participate in the solemn ordinance.
