Already notice is being given of application at the next sitting of the legislature for the incorporation of a railway company from the neighborhood of the Yellow Head Pass to Bella Coola. The solicitors for the applicants are Wilson, Senkler and Bloomfield, of Vancouver, and the notice appears in this week's Provincial Gazette. Whoever may be back of the scheme the general route selected is one which has always been looked upon as likely to be eventually the way for a railway

The company will ask power to build, equip, maintain and operate a line or lines of railway from a point on or near the head of Clearwater lake at the head of the North Thompson river, Cariboo, in the province of British Columbia, to the forks at the northern and south arms of the Quesnelle lake, thence by the most convenient route to the outlet of Quesnelle lake, Cariboo district; thence along the Quesnelle river to Quesnel Forks; thence following the Quesnel river to Quesnel; thence crossing the Fraser river, and by some feasible and convenient route to a point near Black Water; thence

convenient and feasible route to the Salmon river to a point near the forks thereof; thence by convenient and feasible route to the Bella Coola river; and to construct, maintain and operate the Bella Coola, with the power to equip, construct, maintain branch lines to Barkerville and Horsefly, with power to equip, construct and maintain wharves, docks, piers, bridges, roads, ways and ferries and to operate said railway by steam, electricity or any other power, and to build, own and maintain wharves and docks in connection with the same, and to equip and maintain steam and other vessels and boats and operate the same in any navigable waters within the province, and to build, equip, operate
