

## RY. PASSENGER SERVICE REDUCED TO A WAR BASIS

Most Drastic Measures to Go Into Effect on U. S. Roads Beginning December 10th.

New York, Dec. 5.—Passenger service on railroads in the Eastern region, extending as far West as St. Louis and Chicago, was reduced to a war basis today by drastic measures effective December 10, issued by A. T. Harding, Regional Director.

In some respects the order was even more sweeping than those issued during the war. For the first time since the 20th Century Limited was put in operation between New York and Chicago on the New York Central, about twenty years ago, it was cut from the schedule to save fuel.

The orders affect virtually 150 railroads included in the region. No special trains are to be run for business or pleasure travel, and only sections of regular trains will be operated except in case of coach travel between cities of dense population.

## OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN ART OF THE SHIP BUILDER

Students in Los Angeles High School, Harbor District, to Have Shipbuilding Course.

Los Angeles, Calif., Dec. 5.—Students in the harbor district high school of Los Angeles are to be given opportunity of learning shipbuilding in the regular course of study, according to announcement made today by the Board of Education. The decision to graduate young men of the high school as trained craftsmen, competent to command high wages, was reached after success had been attained in an emergency shipbuilding class.

There will be day and night classes in shipbuilding, including welding, blue print reading, mechanical drawing and shipfitting. Five certified instructors will be in charge. The initial enrollment of 600 is expected to be increased to 1,000. The normal demand for shipworkers in the Los Angeles yards is about 15,000 men.

London, Dec. 5.—A wireless despatch received here from Berlin says the newspapers in Berlin have been authoritatively informed that the Berlin authorities know nothing whatever of reported impending forcible measures of the Entente, such as an ultimatum, with reference to the signing of the protocol and new notes inhibiting the manufacture of arms. The despatch says that negotiations with Paris are about to be resumed and that the foreign office denies the report that Minister of Foreign Affairs Mueller has resigned.
