## St. John Women As Club Members

Many Societies All Doing Splendid Work--Sketch of Largest Organizations.

There is much activity in the Women's Societies in St. John. Far from any slackening of effort, members are taking up the burden and responsibility of citizenship and in every way striving to make better of their lot. The lot of others perhaps less fortunate than themselves. It may be work for the city or nation or in child welfare, such as the various committees into which the Local Council of Women is divided. This council which is the federation of women's societies, is not a money-making organization and thus very seldom holds teas, sales, or entertainments for which a fee is asked. They take a deep interest in all matters relating to the care or treatment of women and children, and in several much talked of cases have recently been able to accomplish much good through the energy of officers and members. The Council has welfare work which has been carried on since the time of its formation and is the originator of most of the reforms in the city, such as having a motor at the police court, the formation of the Victorian Order of Nurses, the establishment of the Boys' Industrial Home, women census and women on School, Library and Hospital Boards.

The I. O. D. E.

Men sometimes talk of efficiency and organization when speaking to women and then appear rather surprised to hear of nationally organized societies with National, Provincial, Municipal and Primary "Chapters" as the Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire call their branches. This Order has in St. John nine Primary Chapters and a Municipal Chapter. There is a Provincial Chapter, which is in close touch with the National. This Order was instituted long before the Great War for patriotic work and since the Armistice has launched an educational War Memorial for the children of soldiers or sailors. To fulfill all pledges to this as well as to keep up their well-known philanthropic work in the city, their interest in public schools and their many contributions to all worthy causes, all Chapters are kept busy. It is difficult for Chapters to find a time to hold an entertainment so many different ways of raising funds have been planned and no one Chapter must clash with another. Each Chapter has its friends, however, who support any undertaking as well as the generous response of the general public to an organization which has made its place in the Dominion.

Canadian Club

The Women's Canadian Club, whose annual meeting is to be held shortly, is a very successful Club, and one which, in war time, originated many fine enterprises for the comfort and well-being of the soldiers. The organization has gone back to its educational work and has been fortunate in securing many of the best speakers heard in St. John. The members

A recently formed Society is the Catholic Women's League which with its band of splendid workers will be a power for good. In other societies, members of this new federation have been most faithful in caring for immigrants and are noted for their benevolent efforts among the needy in the city.

Missionary Societies, in connection with the churches, are also organized, locally, provincially and nationally, so that their members can be relied upon for a call at very short notice. St. John women appointed as delegates from these and other organizations, represent the city at large conferences and the city may well be proud of them chosen for the part they play in discussion or on the platform giving addresses, cannot be too highly praised.

Care For Soldiers

Never ceasing for a moment its care for soldiers in hospital or preparing so as to be instantly ready for any emergency, the Red Cross Society sets an example to any who might think that the need for work is over. The health programme of this world-wide society alone would call for admiration and support.

Few persons realize the large number of women in the city who are members of the Ladies' Orange Benevolent Association and who carry out all kinds of good work strongly supporting all efforts towards the care of orphans and many other channels of philanthropy.

There are also many other societies in whose ranks men are included and whose work is far reaching, and of the utmost benefit such as the Associated Charities, the Society for the Prevention of Tuberculosis, the Animal Rescue League, The St. John's Ambulance Association and others too numerous to mention.

The Y. W. C. A.

The Young Women's Christian Association is a plant of very rapid growth in St. John, and is only hampered by lack of funds from further advancement. Its ranks are becoming overcrowded and its success on providing healthy recreation and happy places for girls to spend their leisure hours is meeting a great need.

In addition to these few named there are any number of women's sewing clubs, or clubs for social amusement which yet include the support of some deserving cause in their aims. There are Alumnae Societies which foster love of learning and better place and of fellowship with other women. Most St. John women feel that in helping others they are none the less good housekeepers, mothers and home-makers. They try

Take it all in all, the woman who escapes being a club member is almost unique. 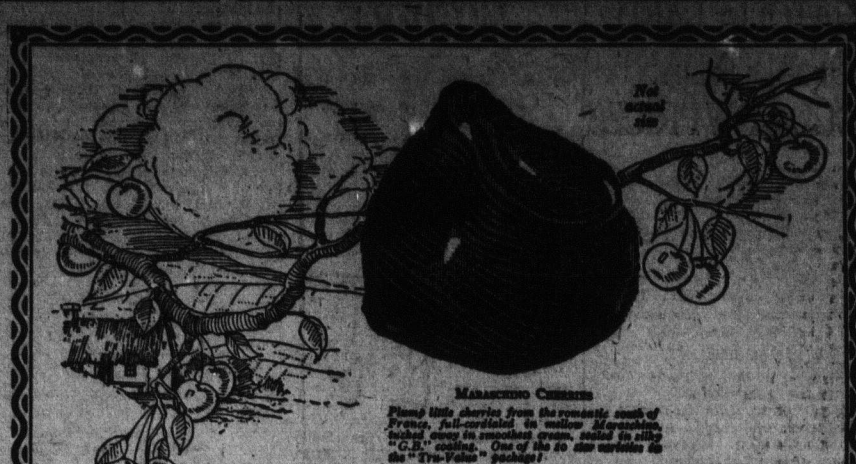
