GOVERNMENT.

British Columbia's Government consists of a Lieutenant-Governor, an Executive Council or Cabinet of six members (who are elected members of the Legislative Assembly), and a Legislative Assembly of forty-two (including the Cabinet Ministers), elected for the constituencies into which the Province is divided. Manhood suffrage prevails and voting is by ballot. The Cabinet is responsible to the people, and may be deposed from office by an adverse vote of the Legislature. The Legislature is elected for four years and holds annual sessions at Victoria.
