Anno Quadragefimo Secundo Regis, GEORGII III. 1802 Reign, entitled, an Act for granting to His Majer certain Duties on Wine, Rum, and other diffilled Spirituous Liquors and Brown Sugar, for the pupple of paying the interst, and reducing the principal of the Fublic Debt of this Province, and overy matter, claufe, and thing contained in this and in 11 and every of the bore recited Acts, and allo in all fuch Acts as have been made in explanation, amendment, or angration, of any or either of faid Acts, shall be, and are hereby continued in Toric, until the thirty-first day of July, which will be in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Two

CAP. XIV.

An Act in alteration and amendment of an Act, made in the thirty-third year of the Reign, of His prefent Majefty, entitled, An Act, for providing for the fupport His Majefty's Government by laying an additional Duty on Wine, Rum, and other Articles therein mentioned, and for encouraging the Agriculture, Fifheries, and Commerce of this Province.

Preamble.

3d. hereafter to be paid on each gallon of Wine imported from the Azores or Weflern Islands. WHERAAS the duties at prefent parable by Law upor low priced Wines, are found too high, and in many cafes amount to a prohibition; and outereas a beneficial Trade might be carried on between the inhabitants of this Province and the Azores Iflands, provided the faid Duties were reduced :

I Be it therefore enaded, by the Lieutenand-Governor, Council and Affembly That from and after the thirty-first day of July next, there thall be railed, levied, collected and paid to his Matchy, his heirs, and Succeffors, for the fupport of the Government of this. Province, upon all Wine the produce of any of the filands called the Azores or Weltern Iflands, which that thereafter be imported into this Province, the rate and duty of Three-pence, and no more, upon each and every gallon of Wine, for imported and brought, which Three-pence, fhall be inflead and in lieu of all duties impoled by the herein recited Act, or any other Act, any thing in the faid Acts to the contrary notwithflanding.
