Council and Chief Commissioner of Public Works and Mines, 17 Jan., 1873. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at g. e., 1867. Re-elected at last g. e., and returned by acclamation on his appt. to office. A Conservative.—*Halifax; Antigonish, N.S.*
