A mem. of the firm of T. & W. Murray, general merchants. Has been a Councillor of Pembroke and Reeve of the same place. Contested North Renfrew unsuccessfully for Commons at last g. e. First returned to Parlt., for present seat., Dec. 1869, on resignation of sitting mem—*Pembroke, Ont.*

Has been a County Councillor, Reeve, Warden of the County, and Mayor of Ingersoll. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. for preset seat.—*Ingersoll, Ont.*

B. at Brockville. Ont., 1830. Ed. there. M. the dau. of J. K. Forsyth, Esq., of Sombra, Lambton, Ont. Called to the Bar, Ont., Hilary Term, 1861. Was County Attorney for Lambton for some years; resigned, 1867. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. for present seat.—*Sarnia, Ont.*
