An Act for the better Protection of the Rights of Property in Lower Canada.

117 HEREAS the period allowed for the bringing of actions for the Pleamble. rescision of contracts in cases of lésion d'outre moilié, and of lésion du tiers au quart; is too extended, and ought to be limited to a term less distant from the date of the sale or of the partition giving rise 5 to such actions; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The action for the rescision of contracts on account of *lésion* The action for *d'outre moitié* in cases of sale, and of *lésion du tiers au quart* in cases account of account of sale or partition between co-heirs, is hereby declared to be prescribed lesion limited by the lapse of two years to be computed from the date of the contract, to two years. 10 the day of such date being included; any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. The action for the rescision of a contract for the causes above Action not to mentioned shall not be maintained in cases in which the purchase money be sustained or consideration of the contract does not include any consideration of cases. 15 an aleatory nature; any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

III. Any party interested may plead this Act in any action pending This Act may at the time of the passing thereof, in case such action was not brought within two years from the date of the contract; any law or pending. usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

IV. This Act shall apply only to Lower Canada. 20
