

it lies, on pay- adjoining the said old line of road or the person or persons having the
 ment of its legal estate therein, according to the frontage of their respective lots there-
 value. on, so soon as such owner or proprietor or such other person or persons as
 aforsaid or any of them, shall have paid to the said Mayor, Aldermen and
 Commonalty of the City of Toronto, the value of their several and respective 5
 pieces of land agreed upon at any time hereafter between the said respective
 owners or proprietors or other person or persons as aforsaid, and the said
 Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of Toronto; and in case
 such value shall not be agreed upon between them as aforsaid within one
 month after the passing of this Act, the same shall be ascertained by arbit- 10
 ration in like manner as is prescribed in the second section of this Act; And
 in making their award in the premises it shall be the duty of the arbitrators
 to take into consideration all the circumstances which have rendered
 necessary the said reference; Provided always, that until the settlement of
 such value and the payment thereof to the said Mayor, Aldermen and 15
 Commonalty of the City of Toronto, it shall not be lawful for any person
 or persons or other party whomsoever, to enclose or in anywise obstruct
 the said old line of road under any pretence whatsoever.
