TITLE 1.

CONSTITUTION AND POLITICAL RIGHTS, LEGISLATION, &c.

CAP. I.

An Act respecting the Legislative Council.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Legislative Council shall be composed of the Members How the Legisthereof appointed by the Crown before the fourteenth day lative Council of July, 1856, and of forty-eight Members elected in the shall be constituted, proportion and at the times and in the manner hereinafter provided; and to this end, the Province shall be divided into forty-eight Electoral Divisions, twenty-four in Upper Canada and twenty-four in Lower Canada, in the manner set forth in Schedule A. 19, 20 V. c. 140, s. 1.
- 2. The Councillors appointed by the Crown as aforesaid, Certain Counshall continue to hold their seats as heretofore, subject to the cillors appoint conditions contained in the Imperial Act of the third and fourth Crown contivitation, chapter thirty-five, "to re-unite the Provinces of nued. Upper and Lower Canada and for the Government of Canada."
