"I fully agree with having a bilingual law school and not two unilingual law schools — one English and one French."



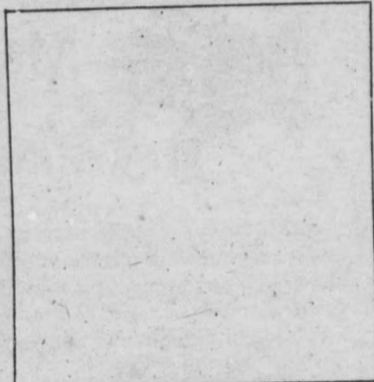

"That is exactly the position which the UNB Law Student Society endorses."



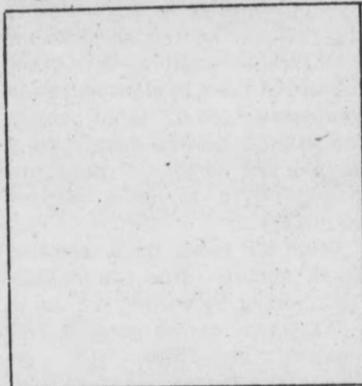

"Only if it's determined by the Acadian people."



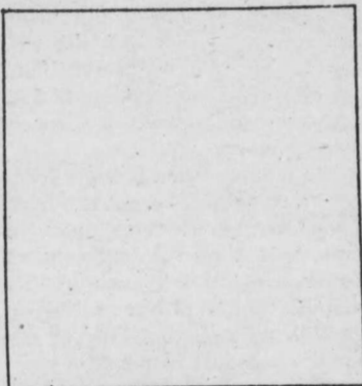

"Yes, I'm in favor of it."



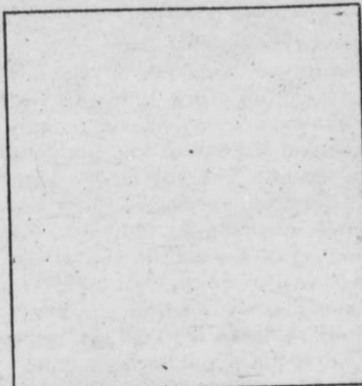

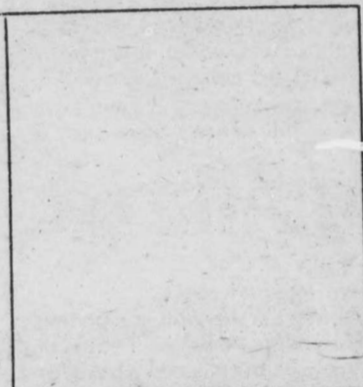

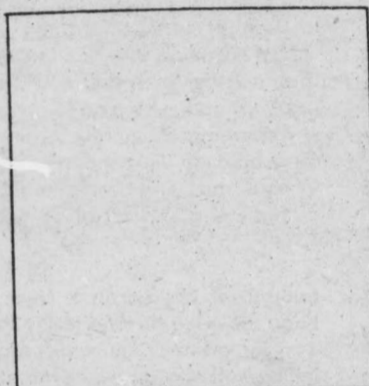
