## Beehives' streak alive

Bringing a winning team back home wasn't as easy as Dixie Beehives coach Norm Dowdall had hoped.

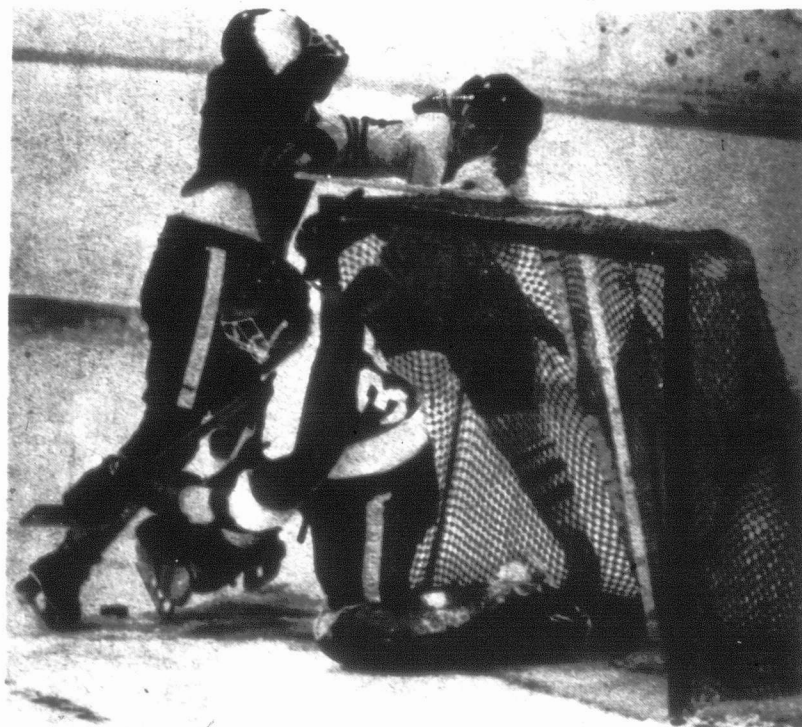
The Beehives gave Dowdall his 11th win in 12 games with only six seconds left in their Central Ontario Junior B match against Georgetown Gemini last week. The Beehives 3-2 win was a good aggressive, fast skating game but Dowdall said his nerves would have preferred less spectacle and more supremacy.

"That Georgetown team has a lot of spirit, a lot of get up and go. We still are having trouble getting our team up when they play anybody but the big boys in the league," Dowdall said.

Dixie's win gives them a firmer hold on second place in the league. Georgetown's record is 11-13-2.

During the first period, Georgetown played an aggressive, game, working the corners and dominating the play to establish a 2-1 lead on goals by Greg Thompson and John Barnes. Trevor Newington was the only Dixie scorer to sneak by Gemini goalie Mark Green, whose strong performance made him one of the night's three stars.

In the second period Dixie decided to play Georgetown at their own game, Dowdall said. "If we don't work the corners when we're at home, we always have a tough time winning. They had the

better part of the play in the first so we came back at them full force in the second," he said.

Although Dixie outshot Georgetown 14-9 in the second, they were unable to get on the scoreboard until late in the third when Paul Otto tied the game with assists from Les Smith and Mark Palmer. Dave Quinn secured the win with a goal at 19:54, bringing his personal record to 21 goals in 22 games.

Quinn later said his wingers Taylor and Mike Sawyer are the two biggest reasons why he's been able to maintain a steady scor-

ing streak.

"I'm really not a scorer, I'm more of a play maker but I've got two good wingers and we all work together well," Quinn said.

Taylor underwent an operation Friday to set his broken nose, sustained Dec. 16 during a game in Thornhill. His absence

could cramp Quinn's scoring style but Taylor said he'd be back on the ice this week. Dowdall said his star winger might have a short Christmas vacation to ensure his health for the remainder of the season.

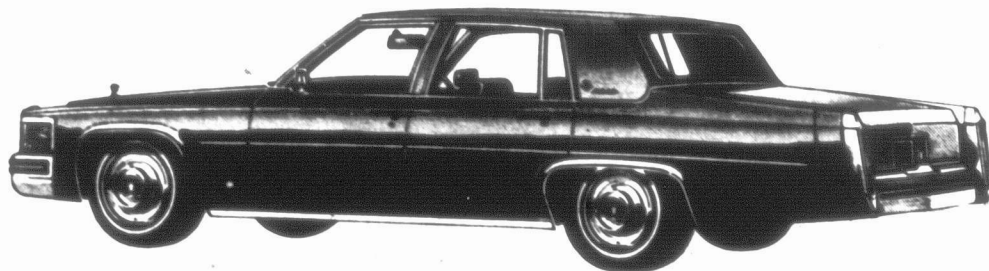
The Beehives travelled to Acton Saturday and will host Orillia tomorrow.
