In the matter of a permit granted to Jasper W. Jones
by the Council many years ago to occupy the North half
of Lot No. 7, Con. 3 Tus. during his natural life. The
Council decided to respect the action of their prede-
cessors who had given this permit to Mr. Jones, but
the property will revert to the Six Nations on his de-
mise and should the committee who will be appointed to
examine a gravel bed on the property think it worth
while to have this bed opened, the Council will open
a road way from the side line opposite the pit.

The Council then adjourned until Tuesday 14th instant
at 10 o'clock A.M.
